Learning highlights this week...

Children in **Owlet Class** have been reading non-fiction books to find out how stars are made. We have been making our own stars for our space area. We have also been exploring fiction through short film clips and having a go at retelling stories. Children in **Owl Class** have been off to the Equestrian Centre grounds again, observing trees in the late autumn. They should now be able to identify oak, beech, sweet chestnut, maple and holly trees from their leaves, and be able to explain the difference between evergreen and deciduous trees. Quiz them when you are out and about this weekend! Children in **Panda Class** enjoyed 'The Power of One' anti-bullying show. We have discussed how to stop physical, verbal and cyberbullying and children recorded their learning as posters you can see displayed in the classroom. Children in **Rhino Class** have been Anglo-Saxon settlers this week. They have designed and built their own settlement, including the chief's house, huts, docks and animals pens. They used similar techniques and materials that would have been available at the time.

The children came dressed in a variety of 'Weekend Wear' including sports kits, pyjamas, onesies and superhero costumes. Lunchtime at School

As you will be aware, we have been trialling amendments to our lunchtime arrangements to improve these.

Our aims are to:

- extend the length of uninterrupted playtime for all pupils by serving the children in one sitting
- promote compassion, respect and good interpersonal skills by seating children of different ages together and organising timings so that they can all to play together
- improve behaviour and reduce noise levels in the school hall during lunchtime

We continue to review and amend our practice as we evaluate the impact of these changes.
