### Learning highlights this week...

Children in **Owlet Class** have had a visit from a space scientist! Clare Rowling very kindly came into school to talk to us about what it would be like to be an astronaut. We have just begun the countdown to Christmas and have started learning some of our nativity songs. Children in **Owl Class** have been given their roles for the Nativity and have started to develop the script. The songs are on the way too! Only a week until the dress rehearsal. After reading *The Egyptian Cinderella*, *Irish Cinderlad* and *Princess Furball* and watching the animation *Penguin Cinderella*, children in **Panda Class** enjoyed writing their own versions of the Cinderella and designed some impressive front covers for their story booklets. We are very grateful to Miss Mundy and Miss Lloyd who joined the class to help us create papier mache masks based on those used by Ancient Romans. Children in **Rhino class** have been learning about the poetry of Charles Causley and enjoyed performing some of his poems. They have been writing their own descriptive poetry using similar themes and style. ### Sports Highlights

They improved in every match and without exception said they enjoyed it and would like to play more; it was lovely to see the girls choose to improve their football skills the following day in the playground! ### Flu Vaccination session

The School Nurse Team will be coming into school on **4<sup>th</sup> December** to vaccinate children in Reception class and Years 1, 2, 3 & 4 who have returned their consent forms with parental consent. ***Children returning their consent forms late may not be vaccinated in the school session.***

### Is your child wheezy or unwell?

If your child has a wheezy episode up to 3 days before the school session, please inform the School Nurse Team as this would mean they were not fit enough to be vaccinated. If your child has taken steroids up to 2 weeks before the school session this also means they are not fit enough to have the vaccination in school, please inform the School Nurse Team.

### Catch up clinics

Children not vaccinated on the day as absent or unwell, or who have returned their consent forms too late (unless you have informed us) will be invited to the School Health Nurses catch up sessions. Only children who are at high risk from flu due to one or more medical conditions can have this vaccination at their GP surgeries.

### Arrangements for Emergency Closure of the School

On rare occasions, for example during extreme weather conditions or when the school has no heating or water, the Headteacher and Chair of Governors may have to take the decision to close the school. It is school

policy to keep the school open if at all possible, but there are occasions when it would not be possible to operate the school within the health and safety requirements.

In the very unlikely event of an emergency closure during the school day, the school will contact parents via the email contact details kept in school. All children will be kept safely until collected. Please ensure, therefore, that the school has your up-to-date daytime contact details.

In the event of an emergency closure before the start of the school day the school will notify Oxfordshire County Council and the local radio stations and will send a group email to all parents who receive the weekly newsletter. If parents need to find out whether or not the school is closed they should:

- Check their email
- Look on the county public website: [www.oxfordshire.gov.uk/schoolclosures](http://www.oxfordshire.gov.uk/schoolclosures);
- Listen to the announcements of the local radio stations:
  - BBC Radio Oxford – VHF/FM 95.2
  - Heart FM (Oxfordshire) – VHF/FM 102.6
  - JACK FM – VHF/FM 106.8

Parents are advised not to call the radio stations otherwise switchboards can become jammed and prevent the radio stations receiving information from schools. Parents may attempt to call the school, but the school cannot guarantee that there will be someone in the office to man the phone.

Our hot school meals are prepared in the kitchen at Langtree School and delivered to Checkendon in time for lunch. Langtree School may be closed on days when Checkendon School is open. We ask therefore that, if there is snow on the ground but Checkendon School is open, parents assume that hot dinners will **not** be delivered, cancel their lunch online and send their child with a packed lunch.
