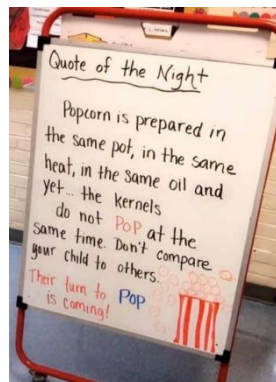

Thank you to Rafe Thomas and his family for tidying up the hedge in Owlets, it makes the space safer and a lot lighter!



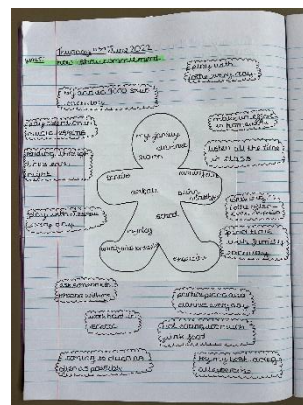
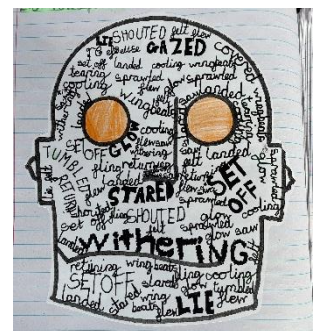
