We have had a number of visitors recently. We enjoyed reviewing our phonics with a Literacy Specialist that initially visited at the start of the academic year. She focused on areas such as the school's phonics programme and use of decodable books, training for staff and reading for pleasure. Thanks to our PTA we were able to order a new series of phonic books from Little Wandle. We are pleased to announce that she was impressed with the progress we have made since her initial visit.
